

Scribble Drawing

Media:

- One sheet of 12 x 18 inch white drawing paper
- Drawing media

Directive:

- Use a marker or pastel to make several large random "scribbling" marks on the paper. Make sure that some lines cross each other, but do not plan your picture. The idea is to have a moderate amount of intersecting lines on the paper when the scribble is finished.
- Take a few moments to look at the scribbles from all directions. You may turn the paper around to see it from different angles. Continue to look at the scribble until you perceive an image formed by its lines.
- After you have found an image, use drawing media to complete the picture. You may add or ignore lines, fill with color, or emphasize lines.
- When the image is complete, write a title and the date on it.
